7th September, 1940 - the start of the blitz. As bombs rained down on London, children were evacuated to the countryside to be kept safe. But what would life be like for them, living amongst strangers – and would they really be safer?

Our play is the story of a group of evacuees from war-torn London trying to adapt to their new life in the countryside. They find their welcome less than warm – bullied by the other children, and suspected of theft by the villagers; but this changes as they become absorbed into a local mystery of enormous international proportions. What will happen to the children when a simple game of spies becomes a matter of life and death?

Come and find out! This play has something for everyone, including bombs, spies, air raids, rationing, and even a couple of dramatic deaths. Find out who saves the day, and who ends up with pie on their face.....
